Selection Criteria for 2024 Quadrangular Teams

To be considered for selection, a player must meet the following criteria:

- Be handicapped and in good standing at a club in the Gauteng North Region
- **U/19 Team** (8) - have played a minimum of 25 counting tournament rounds. The Best 20 differentials to count based on the Gross Dynamic Raring. (GNGU Junior Tournaments, GolfRSA u/19 tournaments, GolfRSA Mens Open Tournaments)
- **U/17 Team** (8) - have played a minimum of 16 counting tournament rounds. The best 16 differentials to count based on the Gross Dynamic Raring. (GNGU Junior Tournaments, GolfRSA u/19 & u/17 tournaments)
- **U/15 Team** (6) - have played a minimum of 12 counting tournament rounds. The best 12 differentials to count based on the Gross Dynamic Raring. (GNGU Junior Tournaments, GolfRSA u/17 & u/15 tournaments)
- **U/13 Team** (6) - have played a minimum of 10 counting tournament rounds. The best 10 differentials to count based on the Gross Dynamic Raring. (GNGU Junior Tournaments, GolfRSA u/13 tournaments)
- **Girls Team** (4) - have played a minimum of 12 counting tournament rounds. The best 12 differentials to count based on the Nett Dynamic Raring. (GNGU Junior Tournament Rounds, GolfRSA Junior and Womens Tournaments)

The Selection Committee may use younger players in an older age group at their discretion and can select one wild card player per team.

In addition to the above criteria, the Selection Committee will also consider the following:

- Performance in International tournaments
- Other relevant factors at selectors discretion such as code of conduct and team involvement.

The final decision of the selection of the team rests with the Selection Committee of the Gauteng North Golf Union and they may alter the published selection criteria without notice. It must be remembered that the aim of the selection process is to identify a team of players that can represent the Union with dignity and honour.
