

GNGU Women's Domestic Order of Merit (DOoM) – Revised November 2022

As from 1 November 2022, GNGU will be implementing a revised Domestic Order of Merit system for our Womens Inter Provincial Teams.

For each counting tournament round, a calculation will be made to work out each player's stroke difference against par. For example, if a player shoots 80 on a par 72 course, their stroke difference will be +8. In order to work out a player's +/- against par, all their stroke differences are added together divided by the number of rounds played.

Selection criteria / tournament conditions will specify minimum number of rounds to be played for each respective DOoM and also specify which rounds count towards the DOoM.

The players on the DOoM Ranking will be listed from best to worst with each players' Stroke Differential being displayed together with the number of counting rounds she has competed in. WD / DQ / NR **do not** count towards counting rounds.

The DOoM may display A & B Division players, however only A Division players are eligible for selection. Further, B Division players may not have all their rounds reflected on the DOoM – due to different tournament setup and formats at different tournaments.
