



## GNGU Womens Inter Provincial Team Selection

The GNGU Womens teams for the 2022 Womens Inter Provincial Championship will be announced after the completion of the All Amateur Series at Copperleaf (17 July 2022)

Players will qualify for the team on the following basis:

- Compulsory tournaments:
  - 3 GNGU Closed events (All Amateur Series / GNGU Closed)
  - 5 WGSA Open\* ranking events

\*Note, these are Open events, not Junior / Mid Amateur / Senior ranking events
- Adherence to all tournament conditions in terms of behaviour and golf etiquette.
- Players will have to play a minimum of 15 rounds to be eligible for selection. Tournaments considered for counting rounds will be GNGU All Amateur Series, GNGU Closed and WGSA Open ranking events. The first of the counting tournaments towards the DOoM (see below) will be the Northern Cape Open which took place in September 2021 and the last tournament will be the GNGU All Amateur Series at The Els Club @ Copperleaf (July 2022).
- A player with two offenses (WD, NR or DQ) may not be eligible for selection in the current season. Offences will be handled on merit by the selection committee.
- Specific allowances may be made for players who only joined GNGU during the course of the selection period.
- All scores will be used to compile a Domestic Order of Merit (DOoM) the ranking order will be published on the website The DOoM is based on a Dynamic Rating and Stroke Difference per tournament, and not based on stroke average. Please see explanation of DOoM for more information as to how this Order of Merit works.
- The published DOoM will reflect **all** players. It is the player's responsibility to ensure they are eligible for selection by meeting the above mentioned requirements.
- WGSA rankings will be used as a further guideline if needed.
- The top 4 players according to selection criteria compulsory tournaments and DOoM will automatically be selected, while the final 2 players may be selected as wild cards.
- Players will be expected to be available to attend squad sessions throughout the year.
- If selected to represent GNGU, players will be expected to make themselves available to play stipulated practice rounds, including the foursomes events. If a player elects not to participate in these rounds she may be replaced by an additional wild card player. This requirement will only be waived in exceptional circumstances.

The Selection Committee reserves the right to amend these published conditions in exceptional circumstances. It must be remembered that the aim of the selection process is to identify a team of players that can represent the Union with dignity and honour.

Players who have recently joined the Gauteng North Golf Union to please notify the GNGU office should you not appear on the DOoM.
