



## GNGU Womens Inter Provincial Team Selection

The GNGU Womens teams for the 2024 Womens Inter Provincial Tournament will be announced after the completion of the GNGU All Amateur Series on 14 July 2024 at Centurion CC

Players will qualify for the team on the following basis:

- Minimum of 14 completed counting tournament rounds.  
Counting tournaments include: -
  - GNGU All Amateur Series
  - GNGU Closed
  - All Womens Golf South Africa Open National Ranking tournaments. (note, Open tournaments refer to tournaments that do not have age restrictions)
- Must have an A Division Handicap Index.
- Adherence to all tournament conditions in terms of behaviour and golf etiquette.
- A player with two offenses (WD, NR or DQ) may not be eligible for selection in the current season. Offences will be handled on merit by the selection committee.
- All scores will be used to compile a Domestic Order of Merit (DOoM) which will be published on the GNGU website. The DOoM is based on Gross Over Par for each tournament and then calculating the average score based on the top 14 scores of a player's rounds played.
- Players need to have been an affiliated member of a GNGU Club for 6 months or longer prior to the tournament. Players who have only joined GNGU within 6 – 12 months prior to the tournament will have their ranking calculated manually.
- The published DOoM will reflect **all** players. It is the player's responsibility to ensure they are eligible for selection by meeting the above mentioned requirements.
- WGSA rankings will be used as a further guideline if needed.
- The selection criteria is based on the assumption that the format of the 2024 Inter Provincial tournament will remain the same (teams of 4 players). Should this be changed, GNGU will amend the criteria accordingly.
- The top 3 players that have met the selection criteria on the DOoM will automatically be selected, while the final player may be selected as a wild card.
- Players will be expected to be available to attend squad sessions throughout the year.
- If selected to represent GNGU, players will be expected to make themselves available to play stipulated practice rounds. If a player elects not to participate in these rounds she may be replaced by an additional wild card player. This requirement will only be waived in exceptional circumstances.

The Selection Committee reserves the right to amend these published conditions in exceptional circumstances. It must be remembered that the aim of the selection process is to identify a team of players that can represent the Union with dignity and honour.

Players who have recently joined the Gauteng North Golf Union to please notify the GNGU office should you not appear on the DOoM.
