Dear Unions and players,

Please note that, following a meeting and vote by the SAGA and WGSA National Executive Councils, and in consultation with the Board of GolfRSA, the following decision relevant to all national team events (for example, Inter-provincial or provincial teams tournaments) played under the auspices of GolfRSA, was made. From 1 April 2022:

- All players selected to play in a provincial team (national IPT) who are eligible
 to be vaccinated, will be required to present an official vaccination
 certificate showing that they are fully vaccinated.
- Any support staff, team managers or assistant managers accompanying teams will be required to be fully vaccinated.
- All participants in Inter-Provincial or national teams events will be required to register on HealthDocs and upload their vaccination certificates under the applicable tournament code.
- Any player who has recovered from contracting COVID-19 and therefore, in accordance with national regulations (currently 30 days) can not be vaccinated, will be permitted to participate. The player must present proof that they contracted COVID-19, in the form of a positive Rapid Antigen or PCR test, and a confirmation of recovery letter from their doctor.

Any person who is unable to provide proof of vaccination will not be permitted to participate as a provincial team member in any national team event.

In addition, the following applies to all GolfRSA tournament staff:

 All GolfRSA staff, invited or contracted staff and any third party required to perform services for, or interact directly with, players at national events (individual or teams) will be required to be fully vaccinated, also from 1 April 2022.
