

GNGU LEAGUE 2026 CHANGES TO LEAGUES FOR 2026

League Rules

The following rules have been amended for the 2026 year (based on 2025 rule numbers):

Rule 2: A pace of play policy has been provided on the GNGU website for the implementation of host venues.

Rule 7: Penalty amended to no result for fixture.

Rule 20: Penalty amended to fall in line with MLR H - 1.

Rule 22: Penalty clarified to deduction of 1 game point on league table.

Rule 23: Amended to fall in line with MLR H2. Rule 23.1 added to specify that each team must have an adult as manager present at the beginning and end of the round who will be responsible for the team.

Handicap League

Groups have been modified from two groups to three groups. With a maximum of 9 teams per group.

Women's 25+ League

Women's Mid Am League changed to Women's 25+ League. The Minimum age for league changed to 25 years old on the tee. Venue changed to central venue.

Women's Saturday League

Maximum shots to be given between the lowest and the highest handicapped player to be capped at 18 shots given.

Rate

The 2026 GNGU competition and league rate is R 270.

Cart rate – Home Clubs Member Rates.

League periods

Scratch League: 1 February - 12 July 2026

Mid Am Scratch League: 25 July - 26 September 2026

Senior Scratch League: 7 February - 18 April 2026

Senior Handicap League: 5 February - 26 March 2026

Men's Handicap League: 1 February - 17 May 2026

Junior Handicap League: 7 June - 13 September 2026

Junior Scratch League: 26 July - 30 October 2026

Women's Thursday League: 19 February - 19 March 2026

Women's 25+ League: 21 February - 28 March 2026

Women's Saturday League: 11 April - 13 June 2026

Mixed League: 21 June - 27 September 2026

RULES GOVERNING LEAGUE FOR 2026

In order to ensure the efficient and smooth running of the golf leagues, the following general rules, as well as those rules applicable to the various individual leagues, were formulated and approved for 2025 by the clubs affiliated to the Union:

1. The Union organizes and controls league matches for men and women. Any player, team or club found to be in breach of these general rules or those applicable to the various leagues shall be guilty of an offence. Penalties will be applied as per the league rules. In addition, matters may be referred to the Disciplinary Committee of the Union, for further investigation and action if necessary.
2. All league matches are to be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as laid down by the R & A as well as the local rules of the Club where the match is being played. A pace of play policy has been provided on the GNGU website for the implementation by the host fixture.
3. All teams must adhere to the host club's dress regulations, both on and off the field of play. This must be established beforehand, as well as the tee off times, the caddie policy, driven golf carts, soft spikes and any other matters particular to the host club.
4. Clubs entering a league team must ensure that they meet all their league obligations, including the use of Score Capture. In the event of a team not fulfilling its league obligation on a specific date, they will forfeit their points and, after review, may not be permitted to enter said league in the following season.
In addition, any club which does withdraw from a league obligation within the week of said match will be responsible to the host club for the playing fees. A Club entering then subsequently withdrawing from a league (prior to or during the season) will be subject to a R 1000.00 fine.

5. Score Capture

5.1 Clubs are responsible for accurately uploading their correct team players on the Scorecapture Online System. The uploading of team names can be done at any stage before the fixture, but there will be a cut-off 120 minutes prior to the first recorded tee off time. Clubs may elect to “hide” their team from the opposing team, but these will become visible 2 hours before the club’s recorded first tee time.

5.2 The Scorecapture Online results must be completed and verified by both the home and away team captains and submitted on the date of play. Details on how to submit via the Scorecapture Online process is available in the Scorecapture League Manual.

- Teams may not change their order within the 120 minutes prior to tee off unless approved by a GNGU official.
Penalty for breach: loss of a match point.
- Teams failing to load teams on time, submit and verify their results on the day will receive an official warning for the first offence and thereafter a loss of match point for each occurrence.
- Queries on results to be forwarded within 7 days of the fixture, failing which the results stand.

6. Players may only play league for the Club where they are handicapped. Players may only play for one Club in a specific league, but may play for another Club in a different league if they have moved their handicap.

6.1 If a club enters more than one team in a specific league, players may not play for more than one team in the same league.

Penalty for breach of rule: Loss of game for the player.

7. Clubs may not change their published venue for league matches. No league fixture may be postponed to a date later than the published fixture date. The Union reserves the right to change venues and published dates where deemed necessary.

Penalty for breach: no result for fixture.

8. Golf carts are not allowed in the Men's Scratch nor all Junior Leagues, with the exception of games being played at motorized cart only venues, or if the player produces a valid recent medical certificate.

Penalty for breach of rule 8: Loss of game for the player.

9. Clubs shall strive to reserve the first tee off times for all league matches or by mutual consent a time that will suit both teams. Where both teams cannot agree to a suitable time, the host Club must book tee off times, with the last time no later than 08h00 for a morning field and no later than 12h00 for an afternoon field fixture.

10. Clubs hosting league matches must allocate league times by name of club and should a club phone to confirm their tee off times they must send the time sheet to the relevant person. It is the home club's responsibility to ensure the correct tee times are loaded onto Score Capture.

11. Womens Saturday League, Mixed League and Junior Handicap League must be played according to playing handicap order as stipulated in the rules of these leagues.

Senior Scratch League to play according to their Handicap Index.

Penalty for breach of rule 14: Loss of match for team.

12. Where a club team is sponsored, the members of the team may have on their uniforms the emblem of the team, and the small names or logos of either or both the sponsor and the manufacturer. The sponsor's or the manufacturer's name or logo must not appear more than once on each garment and must not exceed a perimeter measurement of 220mm.

13. Clubs must furnish the Union with the name and contact details of the captains / managers of their league teams before the commencement of the league season.

14. The result of any incomplete match (due to inclement weather or bad light) will be decided on the status of each game when it was officially abandoned, provided nine holes have been completed. A match is to be considered abandoned when the course has been officially closed for that field (ie. AM / PM). Any game not going through 9 holes will be declared a half.

15. Handicaps, tees and strokes: Please take note the following:

15.1 90% handicap allowance to apply to all betterball leagues.

15.2 The player with the lowest handicap in each 2 or 4 ball shall play off scratch with the lowest handicap then being subtracted from the remainder of the players' handicaps. (In the case of the lowest handicap being a (+) the handicap is added to the handicap of all other players.) Each player on the relevant stroke hole then receives strokes.

15.3 Courses (tees) to be played from -

a) In men's leagues (except senior handicap and SADGA team in mens handicap league) all players shall play off the same course – i.e. white course (historically Club tee)

b) In men's handicap league, only players in the SADGA team can choose to play off either the traditional white or blue course.

c) In the men's senior handicap league all players can choose if they want to play off the white or blue course.

d) In women's leagues all players shall play off the same course – i.e. red course (historically Women's tee)

e) In mixed league, men shall play off the white course and women off the red course.

f) Under 13's may play off the red course (historically Women's tee) in junior handicap league only.

g) Junior Girls must play off the red course (historically Women's tee).

Where Clubs have not conformed with the suggested course colours as per the USGA Course and Slope rating system, players to play off the course that would equate to the same course as mentioned above.

15.4 All players must obtain their course handicap prior to teeing off before each fixture. It is the responsibility of the player to ensure they are playing from the correct handicap.

15.5 Players **must** play off their handicap as on the handicap system. Penalty for breach of rule: Loss of game for the player.

15.6 Where men's and women's strokes differ, all players to play off men's strokes.

16. A game will be declared a tie should there be no winner after 18 holes.

17. Winner of Group: The team with the highest number of points after the completion of all the matches shall be declared the winner. In the event of a tie the team with highest overall game points for the season will be the winner. If the teams are still tied, the result between the two teams against one another will determine the winner. If this is still tied, the result of the number one players against one another, and if halved, the number two players, etc., shall be the decider.

Should more than two teams' points be tied after all the league matches are completed, the team with the highest overall game count will be declared the winner.

18. Promotion / Relegation: Where there are two or more groups competing in a league, the team finishing last in the A group will be automatically relegated. The winner of the B group will be automatically promoted, etc. The winner and the loser will be determined as in point 17 above. This rule will only apply if the league structure has remained unchanged from one year to the next year. Should the structure or number of teams in a league change, the winner of a group will still be promoted however double relegation may occur to balance the groups.

19. Walkovers: Where a team is not able to play a fixture / is a no show, the team being awarded a walkover will only receive the maximum number of game points in order to win the match and not the full complement of games points. The team who has given the walk over will get no game points. (eg in a league with a total of 8 points available, the team awarded with the walkover will get 4.5 games points and the other team 0)

20. Caddies:

20.1 Where clubs allow, outside caddies may be used.

20.2 Juniors: No parents / family are permitted as caddies.

Penalty for breach of rule: loss of hole for each hole in which the player has the prohibited caddy – MLR H1.

21. Players are forbidden from playing Match Play and Stroke Play competitions at the same time.

22. Players must enter scores for handicapping when playing in league. Once a match is completed (i.e., there is a winner), players are permitted to play the remaining holes as “practice”. The score on HNA however needs to be put in Hole-by-Hole and holes after result has been determined must be entered as incomplete. The HNA system will then adjust the gross score to a most likely score based on the algorithm.

Penalty for breach: 1 game point deducted from log should player fail to submit score within the 24 hours of completion of the match. This is to be conducted under peer review.

23. “Defining Who May Help or Give Advice to Players” - Team Managers. Each team may name one advice giver whom players on the team may ask for advice and receive advice from during the round. The advice giver

must not point out a line of play or walk on the putting green when the ball of a team player lies on the putting green.

MLR – H2 applies.

23.1 Junior Handicap and Junior Scratch League.

Each team must have an adult as manager present at the beginning and end of the round who will be responsible for the team..

Penalty for breach of rule: Deduction of 1 game point on log.

24. Transformation: Each team that includes a transformation player will qualify for a ½ (half) bonus game point in each match that includes such a player. Multiple bonus game points are not awarded for multiple qualifying players.

For example, if team A has a qualifying player and team B does not, and each team scores 4 points in the games played plus team A's (1/2) half bonus point, team A will win the match 4.5-4.

For the purposes of GNGU leagues, the following will be eligible for a transformation bonus game point: -

Any person who is a South African citizen, whether by birth or naturalization, who is Black, Coloured, Chinese, Indian.

Junior girls will count towards transformation in the junior leagues, mixed league and womens leagues. The age requirement for a junior girl is 18 years of age, or younger, on the tee.
